

LISSETT & ULROME PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of Parish Council Meeting on 11th January 2017
At 7.00pm, Rickaby Hall, Ulrome

Present: Councillors G Daly (in the Chair), A Bailey, K Riddle and K Binks, ERYC Councillors J Evison and J Owen, Clerk, Tracey Topliss recorded the Minutes.

1. Public Participation (10 mins):

Ward Councillor's Evison and Owen discussed and reported on the following:

- Adverse weather conditions are expected. Guidelines/information has been issued by ERYC.
- Coastal Communities Fund – beach access is being explored. Ulrome may be a possibility although there is no guarantee.
- The Parish Council raised the following issues:
 - LPG Connections – who is responsible for safety checks?
 - A165 has become an accident hotspot. Can anything be done?

It was also agreed that the name of the person who originated the board be included on the new board (subject to families' permission).
