Minutes of Extra-Ordinary Parish Council Meeting of 20th January 2016 At 7 pm, Rickaby Hall, Ulrome

Present: Councillors G Daly (in the Chair), A Bailey, P Wilson, R Watson and K Riddle.

1. **Public Participation (10 mins)** There were no members of the public present.

Councillor Riddle declared an interest in Finance, payment of Rickaby Hall as she is the Chair of the Rickaby Hall Committee.

4. **To consider any planning applications that may be received:**

- (a) Application 15/03875

Erection of extension to general industrial building site at side following demolition of existing extension
At CB Solutions, New Cut, Lissett
For Mr C Burrell
Application Type: Full Planning Permission

Resolved: that the Council has no objections to this application.

- (b) Application 15/03859

Erection of service block and change of use of land to allow existing site to be used for the siting of 27 camping pods and retention of 3 existing camping pods
At SH Energy Limited, Two Acres, Bridlington Road, Skipsea
For SH Energy Limited
Application Type: Full Planning Permission

Resolved: to object to the application as 30 camping pods in a small space is excessive and overdevelopment and would be creating a holiday camp; that the 60 mph road is dangerous taking into account the increase in traffic movements in an out of the site on a busy, fast road; that the clubhouse has the potential to create noise in Ulrome in particular if an alcohol license was granted for it.
